Project Scope & Background

- This project will upgrade Lois
 Drive from Benson Boulevard to
 32nd Avenue (see map) to improve non-motorized connectivity by constructing a new roadway.
- Improvements may include: new road foundation, new asphalt pavement, new storm drain system, new non-motorized transportation facilities, traffic calming and improved street lighting.
- Lois Drive is a strip-paved road without curbs, gutters, or adequate drainage.
- The road serves an established residential neighborhood, several businesses, and an elementary school, but lacks dedicated amenities for bicyclists and pedestrians.
- The project is a priority for the Spenard Community Council, surrounding facilities and the adjacent multi-family and residental neighborhoods.
